- 10-Meter RTTY Contest (2011)
 - ARRL RTTY Roundup rules, LP and 10m only
- FT8 Roundup (2018)
 - 5 bands
- FT Roundup (2019)
 - FT4 added
- FT Challenge (2024)

FT Challenge

1. Daily default FT4/8 exchange

- Transparent to both contesters and non-contesters
- Sub-bands:
 - Recommended contest sub-bands, and
 - Daily FT4/FT8 sub-bands
- Anyone works anyone

2. Distance-based scoring

- More equitable across worldwide geography
- Accommodates Tx2 shortcut
 - QSO counts without distance points

FT Challenge Strategy

- Alternate between Odd and Even cycles
- Alternate between FT4 and FT8
- Alternate between 5 bands
- S&P in daily sub-bands to get distance points
 - i.e., avoid Tx2 replies to your CQs
- If SO2R:
 - Either FT4 or FT8 on **BOTH** radios
 - use **OPPOSITE** cycles on each radio
